Legal Services

The Pennsylvania Innocence Project responds to requests for legal assistance from innocent people incarcerated across the Commonwealth. **We receive hundreds of letters each year — more than 7,000 to date.** We respond to every request, and evaluate client eligibility and claims of innocence through a rigorous four-stage review process. We have helped to secure the **release of more than 25 innocent people** since we opened in 2009; together, they lost more than 500 years of their lives to wrongful incarceration.

In June of 2022, Project client **Gregory Brown, Jr., reached a successful resolution in his case** that puts his 25-year nightmare of wrongful conviction behind him. Then, in October, **we celebrated our 25th client to be freed, David Valasquez.** David spent 25 years wrongfully incarcerated for a crime he did not commit. He is now home with his wife Tamara, pictured above, and continues the fight to clear his name. Read more about Greg, David, and other clients at PAinnocence.org.

Although Greg and David were convicted on opposite sides of Pennsylvania, their cases have many things in common: both wrote to the Project within a year of our opening; both were teenagers at the time of the crimes for which they were convicted; both served more than 20 years before being released; and excellent pro bono attorneys from Reed Smith supported our work on both of these cases.

Post-Release Services

The Pennsylvania Innocence Project's support for clients does not end at the time of their release. We have expanded reentry services in recent years in order to meet the needs of the wrongfully convicted during their transition to freedom.

This is critically important programming in Pennsylvania, where no compensation law is in place to provide resources to those who have been wrongfully convicted.

In 2022, we were able to return to offering reentry activities to participants in an in-person format. Our support group has returned to meeting in person, providing a supportive environment for clients to share their experiences, navigate similar challenges, and continue the journey to healing and empowerment. Several clients also traveled to the annual Innocence Network conference in Phoenix, Arizona, which offers unique spaces for leadership development and for all attendees to connect with others who are active in the fight for social justice.

Community & Advocacy

Our recently adopted strategic plan emphasizes priorities around **increasing legal and reentry services**, and includes priorities around **raising public awareness of the causes and impacts of wrongful convictions, and enhancing advocacy efforts for systems change**. In 2022, our staff spoke at more than 20 events to educate students, community members, and judges about these issues.

We also **increased policy work** this year, meeting with stakeholders to move forward bills: one that would require interrogations to be recorded, which would reduce false confessions; and one that would set up a statewide system to compensate exonerated people for their years spent wrongfully convicted and incarcerated.

We could not do this work without the support of our community and volunteers!

Partnering firms and corporations are listed opposite. We thank all who volunteer on case reviews and serve as co-counsel. In addition, we wish to highlight Littler Mendelson and Vanguard, who have gone above and beyond to lend expertise at no cost on organizational legal questions encountered by the Project.

Our pro bono partners donated **more than 6,000 hours** of legal services this year, valued at nearly **\$3.5 million**.
